The Timken Company invites internship applications from students with experience and interest in Manufacturing and Supply Chain. Students selected for the position will work and complete their internship assignment in one of the company's locations in India.

Duration: Ranges from 8 weeks. Apply for any of the following sessions:

- x Winter: December/January
- x Summer: May/August

Eligibility: Undergraduate students in their junior year and graduate students are eligible to apply for these internships. Students must demonstrate strong analytical, quantitative, problem solving and communication skills. The final decision is at the discretion of The Timken Company.

Potential projects: Students are assigned to projects based on the strategic, sourcing and business requirements of Timken as well as on the expertise and aspirations of students, as stated in their résumé.

Support: The Timken Company provides housing for the duration of the internship. Travel (to and from the US) is student's responsibility.

Things to consider: Winters can be cold in India, but do vary by location. You should be willing to spend the entire duration of the internship in India.

To apply: Submit a focused resume that details your analytical, quantitative, and problem solving skills on a separate page not exceeding one page. You should clearly and succinctly describe your goals from this internship, expected benefits and proposed value you can add to the company. Both your resume and goals should be part of one document.
